

Enchantment Dental is open again following the COVID19 closure and we will be happy to see you!



Patient safety is an integral part of our reopening. Here are just a few of the things we will be doing to keep everyone safe in our Dental Practice:

Patients and staff are asked to wear masks in the common areas of the office. Before proceeding to the treatment rooms, patients will be evaluated with a temperature scan and the COVID 19 screening questions. We will also be asking all patients use hand sanitizer and rinse with Listerine prior to treatment.

To ensure air quality in our office we have installed five air purifiers, two uv sterilizers, an air flow exit and room dividers. We have also limited the type of procedures in our office that tend to create aerosols. The number of patients in the office at any time is limited to three, with social distancing measures in place. Usually the total number of people in the office at one time will be five or less.

Our staff will be wearing additional PPE: including N-95 masks, KN-95 masks, fuller coverage lab jackets, and face shields (for some procedures). As always, rooms are fully sanitized in-between patients, and all instruments are steam and pressure sterilized.
